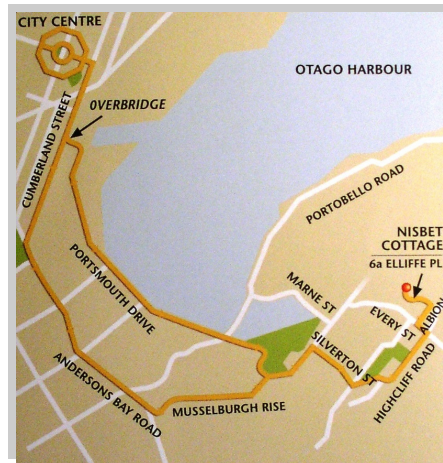

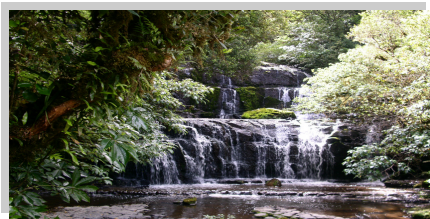

Nature Guiding

Our **Two-Night Package** offers accommodation and breakfast, the **Sunrise Penguin Walk**, and the **Peninsula Excursion & Albatross Encounter**; weather permitting, **Eco Actions** on a special place on the Otago Peninsula will be offered. Picnic lunch is provided.

You are welcome to extend your stay with additional B&B nights. The optional **Catlins Coastal Forest Day Trip** takes you to the largest remnant of native forest on the East Coast of the South Island (minimum of 4 people).

The **Sunrise Penguin Walk** (3-4h) requires a reasonable level of fitness as we descend sweeping sand dunes to a remote beach on the way to our private viewing hide. We observe rare Yel-



low-eyed Penguins on their daily journey to the sea.

The **Peninsula Excursion & Albatross Encounter** (6-7h) is a comprehensive experience of the natural history of the area, focusing on the magnificent Otago Peninsula with its unique botanical features and wildlife. You will visit an eco project in progress,



which concentrates on re-planting the original vegetation of the region. On our route towards Taiaroa Head indigenous and migrating wading birds can be observed along tidal inlets. Experiencing the effortless gliding of a Northern Royal Albatross will add another highlight to your day.

Our **Boutique Lodge** is situated in a quiet area on the hills to Otago Peninsula with panoramic views of the city and surrounding hills. There is a choice of two spacious suites both with king bed and ensuite facilities, as well as television, video, safe and complimentary broadband internet access.
